



**Announcement of Thammasat University**  
**Regarding Admissions for Non-Thai Applicants to BBA International Program**  
**Thammasat Business School, Thammasat University**  
**Academic Year 2017**

---

Thammasat University, hereafter *"The University"*, has announced admissions requirements for the BBA International Program of Thammasat Business School, hereafter *"The Program"*, for Bachelor of Accounting and Bachelor of Business Administration. This announcement contains details regarding the admissions requirements for non-Thai applicants of academic year 2017.

**1. Degrees Award**

The BBA International Program offers Bachelor of Accounting and Bachelor of Business Administration degree. All classes are conducted in English. Throughout the study, the classes are conducted at Tha Prachan Campus of Thammasat University.

The University reserves the rights to announce change in class location if it sees fit and if the issue is approved by Thammasat University Council.

**2. Number of Admissions**

For academic year 2017, the Program sets the number of admissions to approximately 6 students from the pool of applicants. The actual number of admissions may be different if applicants are deemed unsuitable to the Program or the successful candidates do not confirm enrollment to the Program during the specified time period.

**3. Applicant Qualifications**

3.1 Complete high school M.6 or equivalent level from domestic or foreign institutions. Certification must be complying with the condition mandated by the Ministry of Education.

3.2 Has a clean bill of health.

3.3 Willing to follow the University's code of conduct.

3.4 Must have nationality other than Thai. Legally reside in Thailand. A legal proof must be shown.

3.5 Has not been charged or punished for admissions exam misconducts in the past 3 years.

3.6 Must not be enrolled in any other university or higher-level educational institution in Thailand.

#### **4. Admissions Requirements**

4.1 The applicants must possess the aforementioned qualifications. The University reserves the right to withdraw any application with no refund if it is found that the applicant provided untruthful information.

4.2 The applicants must have SAT (Scholastic Aptitude Test) score at the date of application submission. SAT score must be above the minimum score requirement. SAT score must be taken during January 1, 2016 – April 30, 2017. SAT score report(s) must be sent directly to the BBA International Program from the Educational Testing Service (ETS). The code for BBA International Program, Thammasat University is 0288.

If the Program do not obtain the SAT score by the last day of the application period (May 19, 2017), the applicants will not be eligible for interview due to incomplete application qualification.

4.3 Once the University announces the list of applicants who are eligible for interview, the eligible applicants must submit the required documents to the Program. Failing to do so will result in disqualifying the applicants for the interview.

#### **5. Application Submission**

The application is only available online during **May 9 - 18, 2017**.

The application fee payment must be done through the teller payment system at specified bank during **May 9 - 19, 2017**.

##### **Application Submission Procedure**

##### **5.1 Case #1: Domestic applicants**

5.1.1 Complete application form available on [www.bba.tbs.tu.ac.th](http://www.bba.tbs.tu.ac.th) during the specified time period.

- 5.1.2 Verify correctness and completeness of the information before printing out the application form. If the information provided is incorrect or incomplete, please make necessary corrections. The University places importance only to the information provided in the on-line application system. Then, print out the completed application form from the website.
- 5.1.3 Pay application fee via teller payment system at any branches of Krung Thai Bank, PCL. The application fee of 900 Baht per application and applicable bank fee must be paid during the specified time period. Failure to meet payment deadline results in automatic withdrawal of application.
- 5.1.4 Retain application payment receipt from bank for interview day.
- 5.1.5 The applicants can check the payment status and the receipt of official SAT score report from ETS online after 7 working days of payment at [www.bba.tbs.tu.ac.th](http://www.bba.tbs.tu.ac.th).
- 5.1.6 Incomplete applications will be dismissed with no refunds.

## **5.2 Case #2: Overseas applicants**

- 5.2.1 Complete application form available on [www.bba.tbs.tu.ac.th](http://www.bba.tbs.tu.ac.th) during the specified time period.
- 5.2.2 Verify correctness and completeness of the information before printing out the form. If the information is incorrect or incomplete, please make necessary corrections. The University places importance only to the information provided in the on-line application system. Then, print out the completed application form from the website.
- 5.2.3 Print out the application in PDF file format.
- 5.2.4 Make US\$50 payment via telegraphic transfer to Bangkok Bank PCL., Thammasat University Rangsit Campus Branch only.
